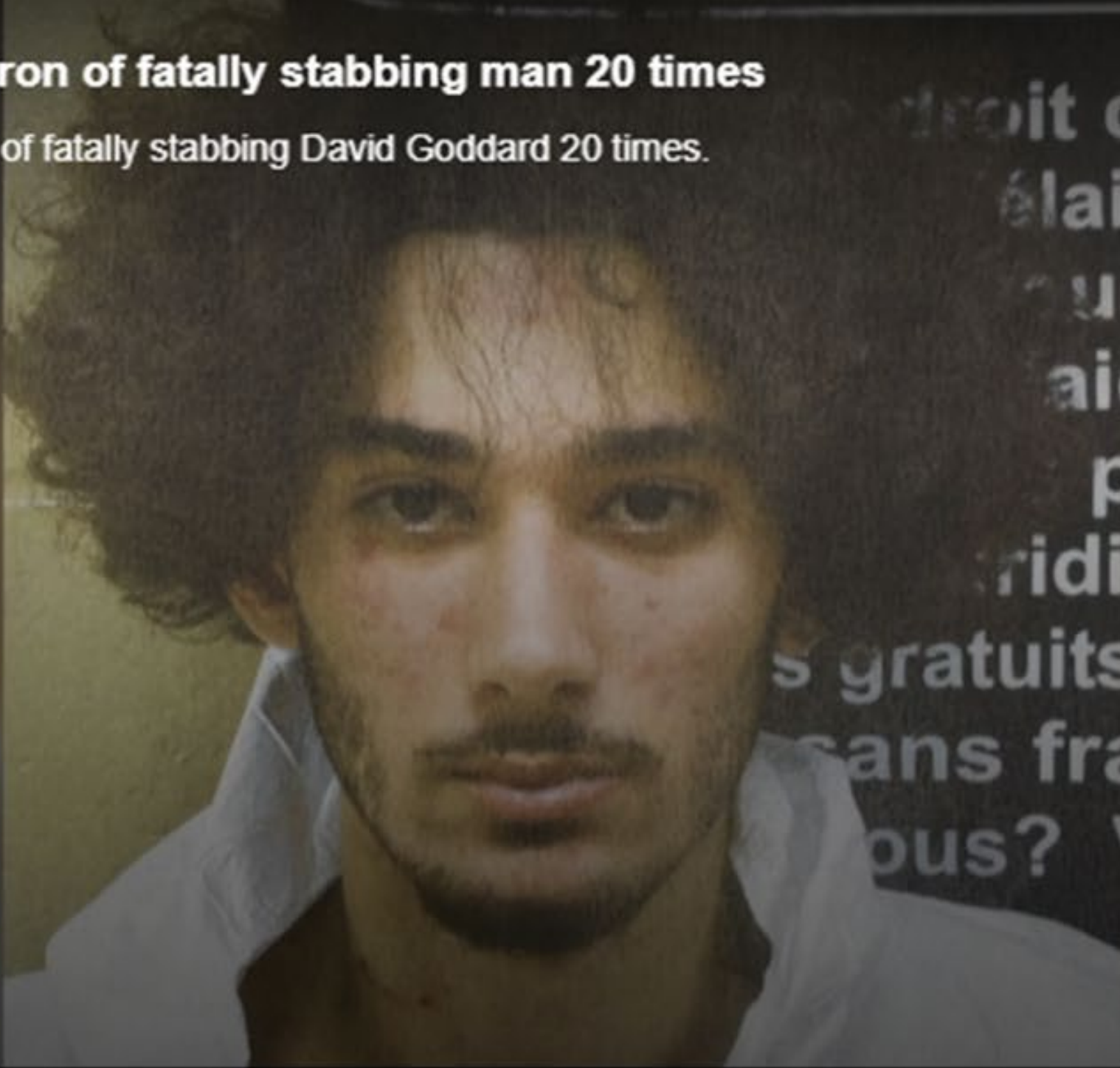

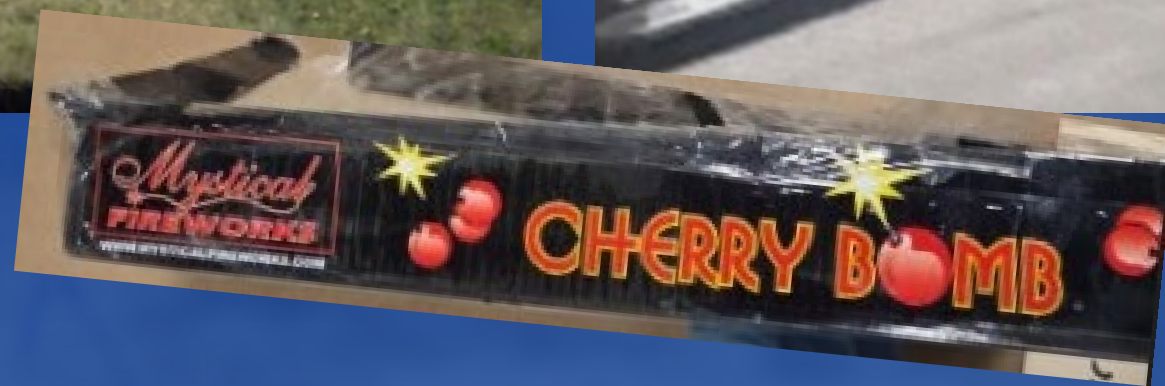

Drug Trafficking Investigation

Four men and two women were charged as officers seized 102 kilograms of cocaine, a loaded firearm, and more than \$135,000 in cash after a three-month probe, York police said.

In October, York investigators started looking into suspected cocaine trafficking along with the OPP and police departments in Toronto, Durham Region, Barrie, and **South Simcoe**, as well as Correctional Service Canada.

Between October and December, nine search warrants were executed at four residences and five storage lockers across Toronto, Vaughan and Barrie, as well as the towns of Espanola, Ont., and **Innisfil, Ont.** An additional search warrant was executed at the Beaver Creek Institution in Gravenhurst, Ont.

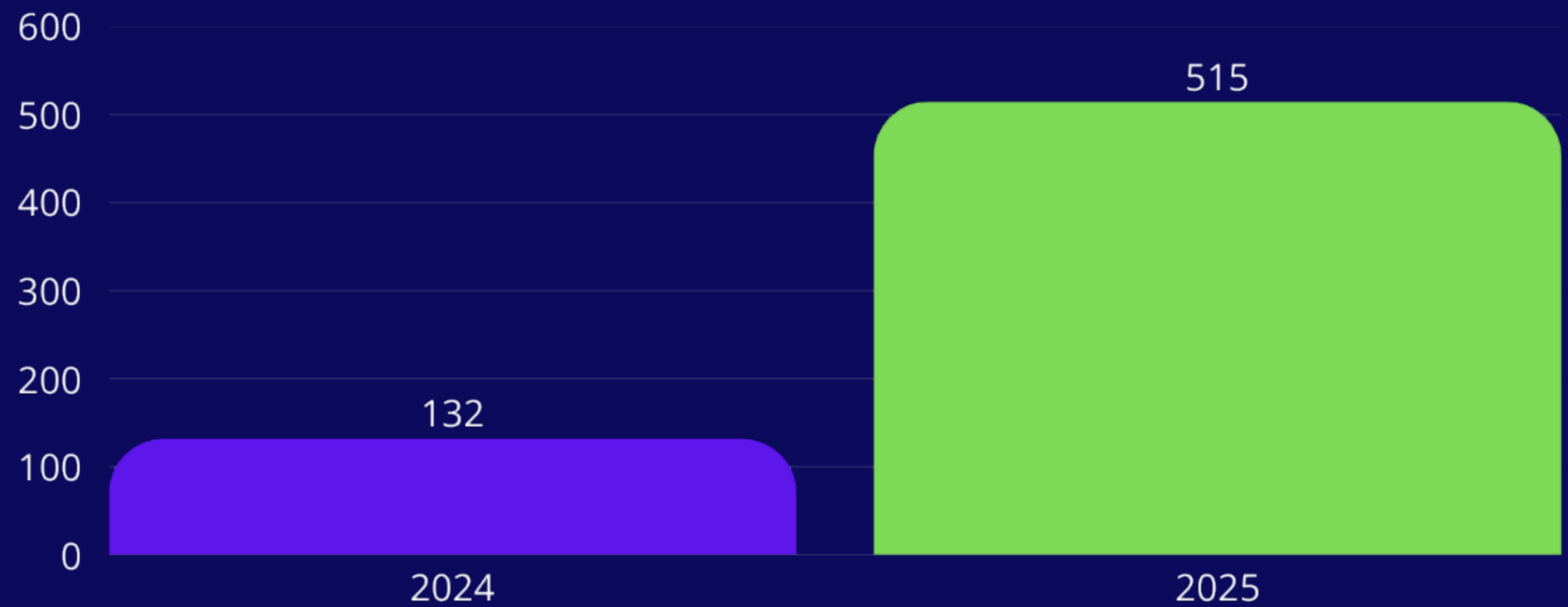

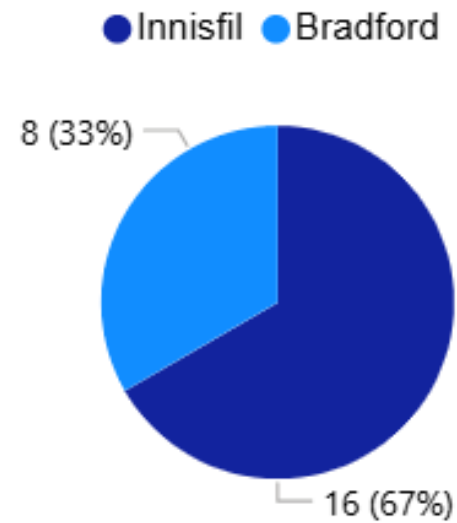

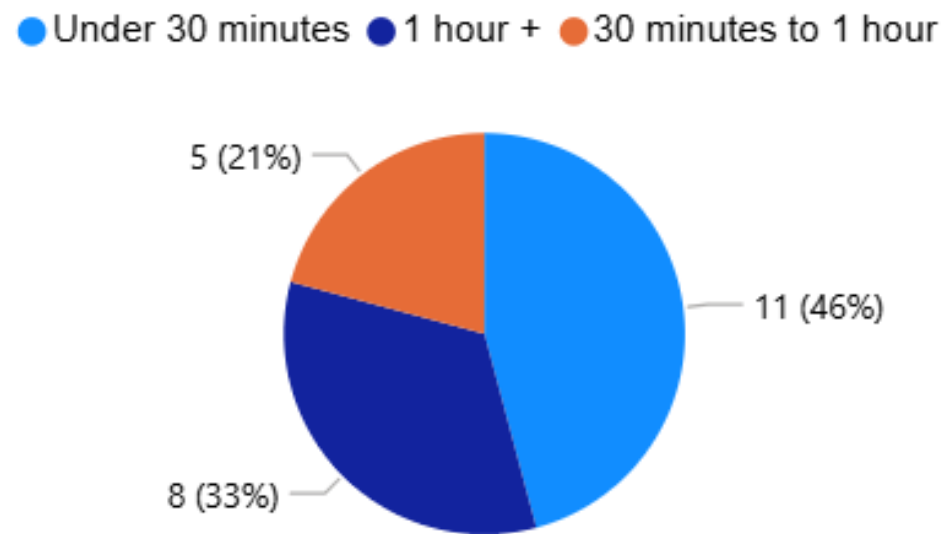

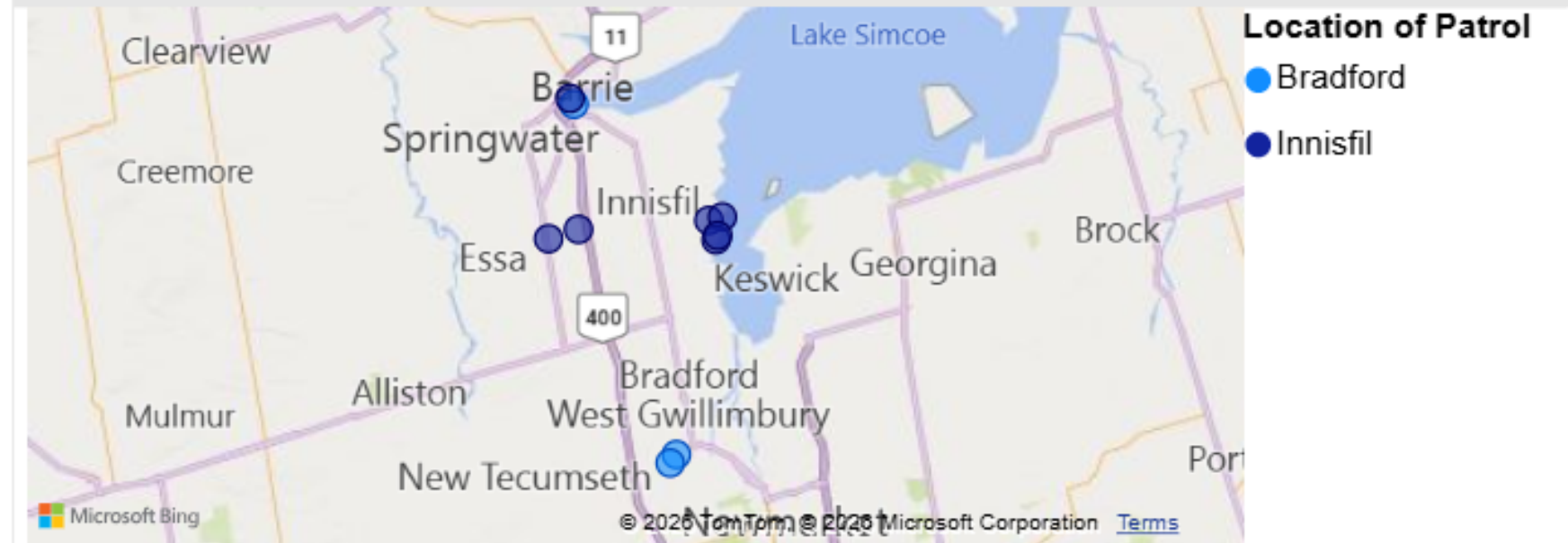
NUMBER OF PATROLS IN INNISFIL VS BWG



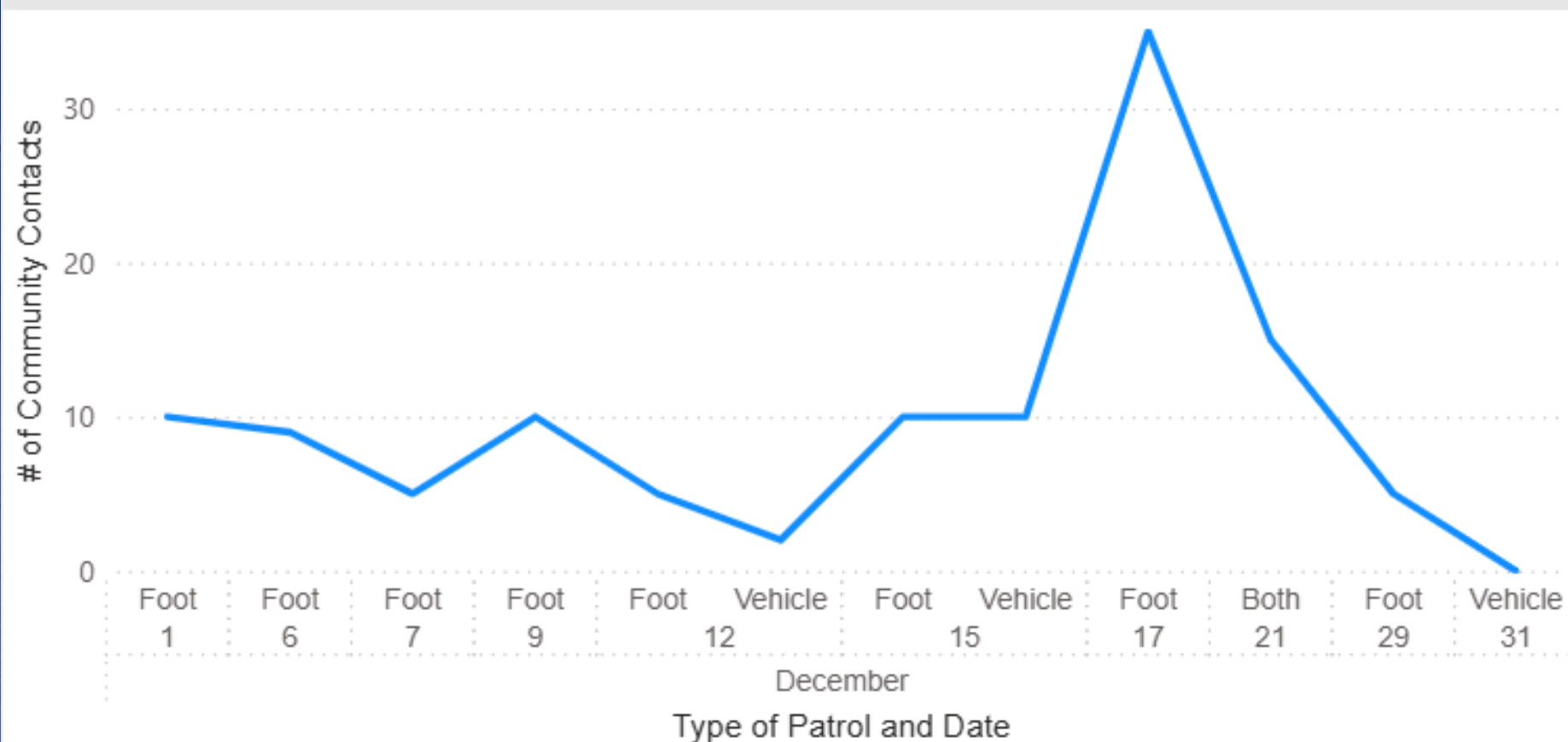
TIME SPENT PATROLLING



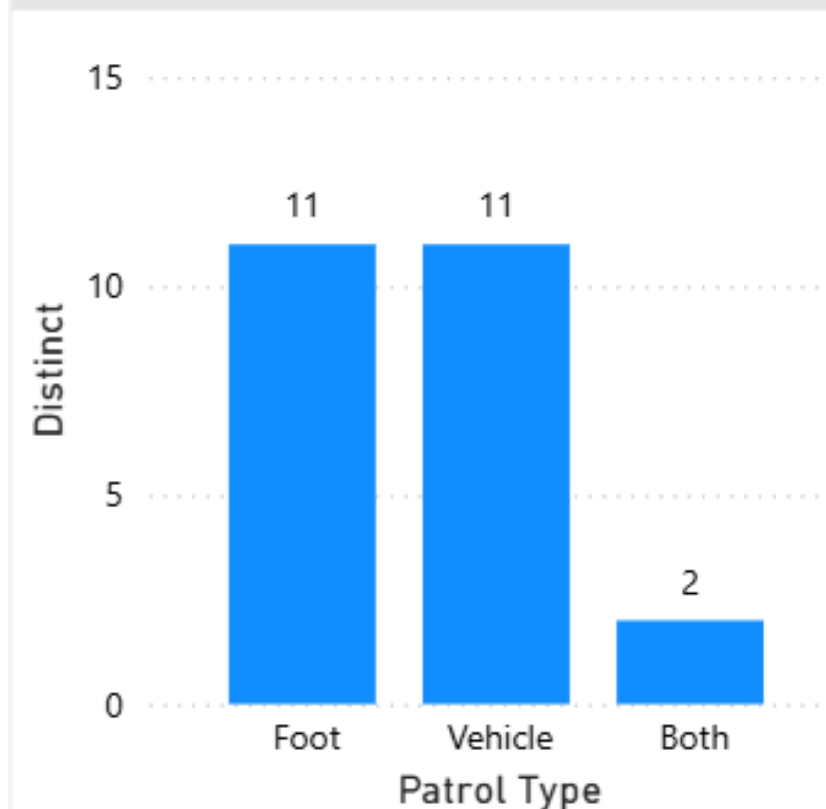
COMMON LOCATIONS OF PATROL

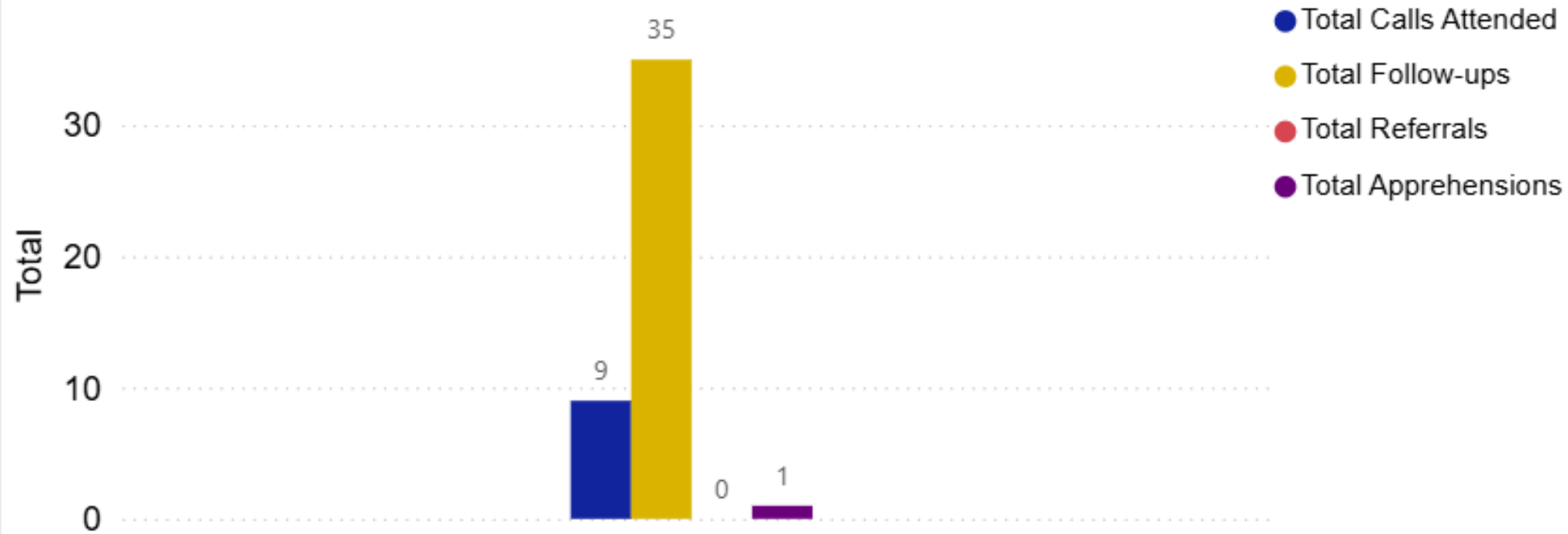

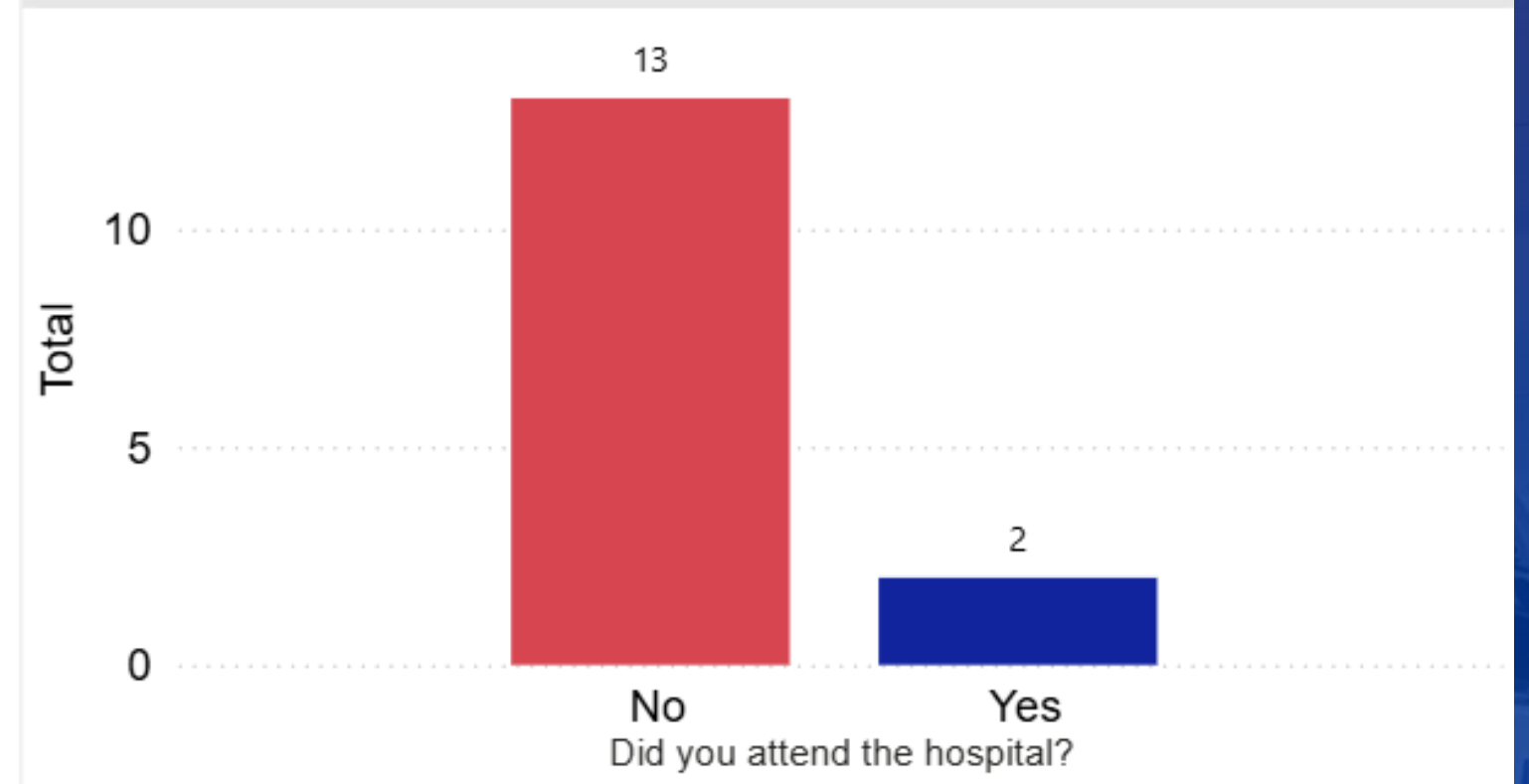

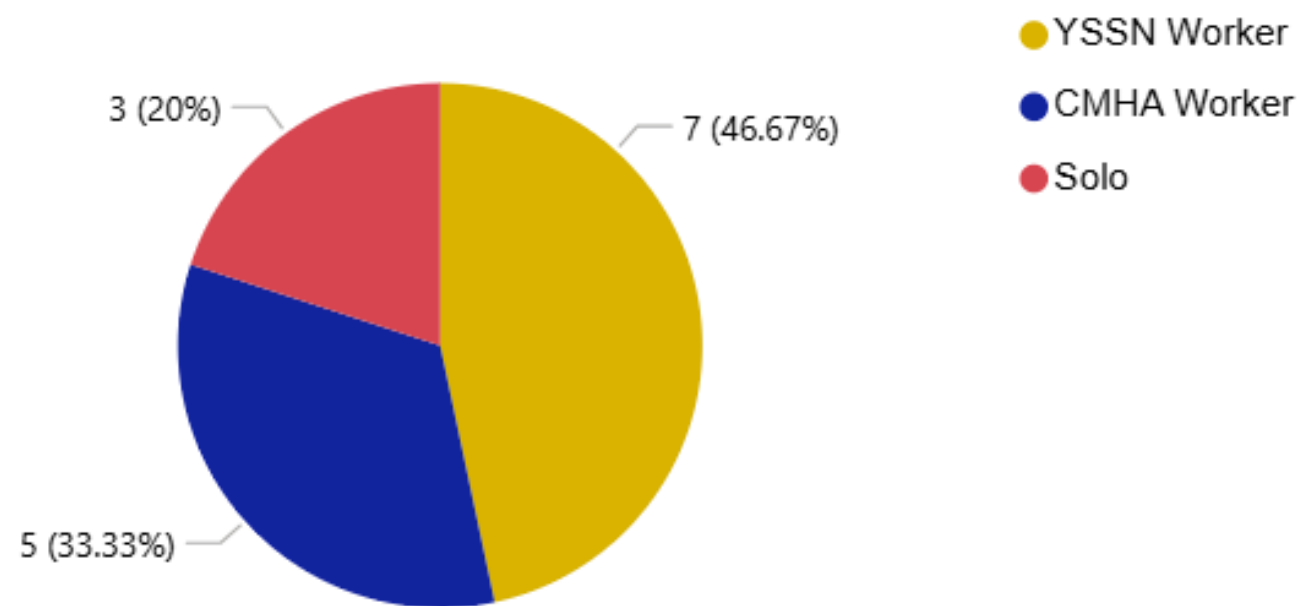

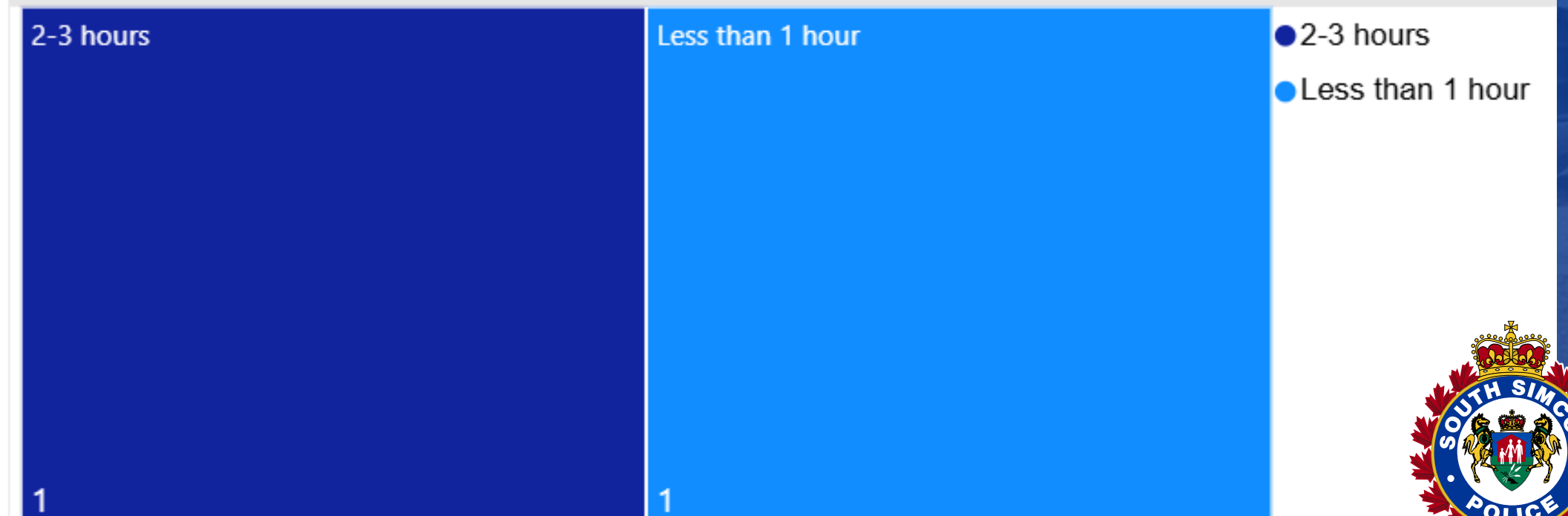
HOSPITAL ATTENDANCE

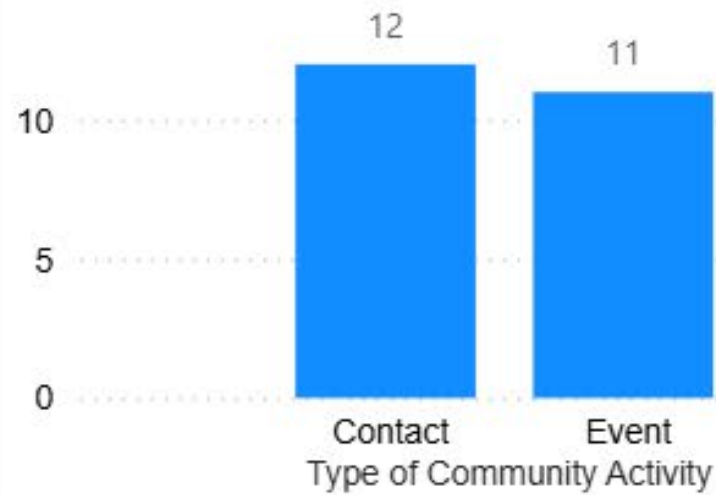

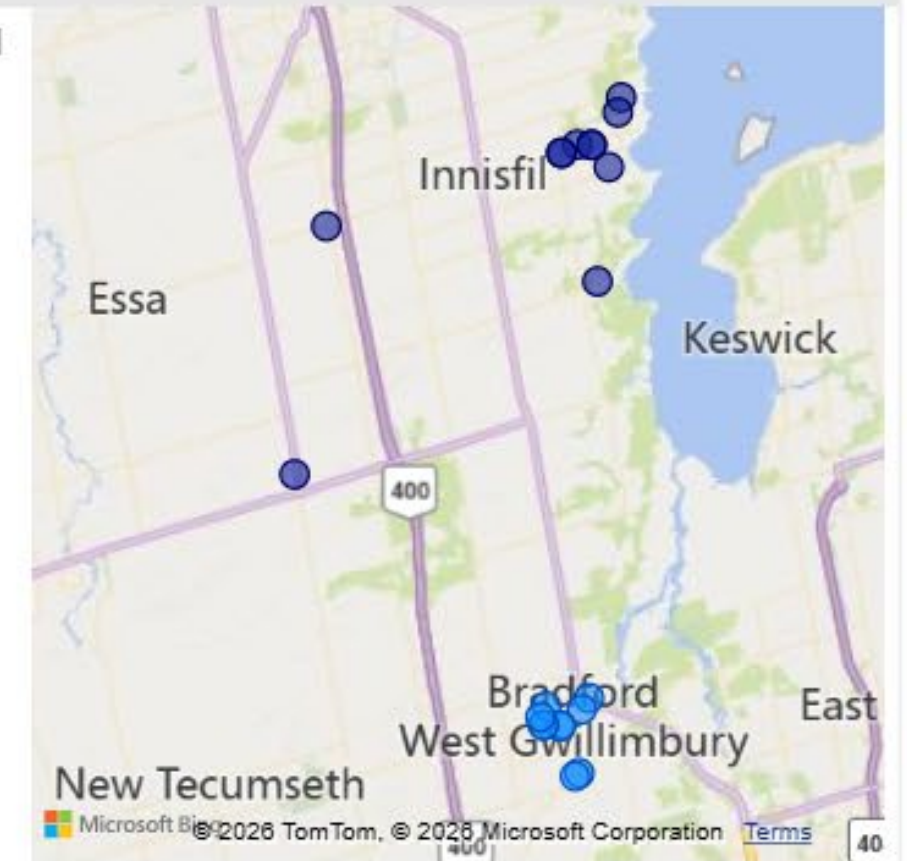

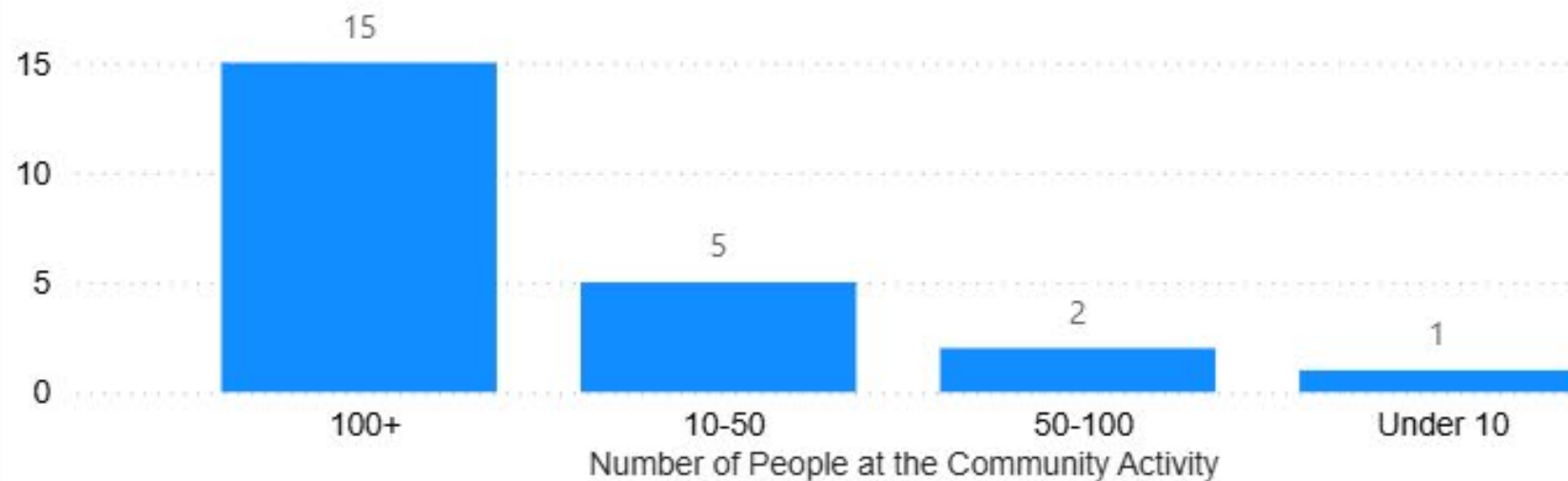


LOCATION OF COMMUNITY ACTIVITY

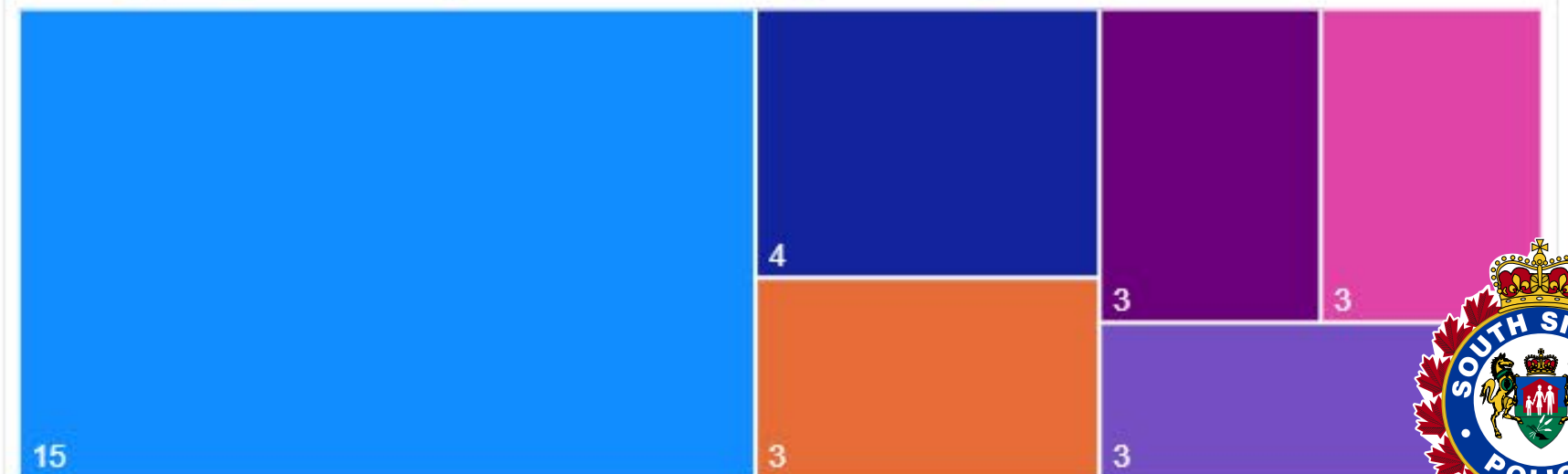


NUMBER OF PEOPLE AT COMMUNITY ACTIVITY AND TOTAL ACTIVITIES ATTENDED

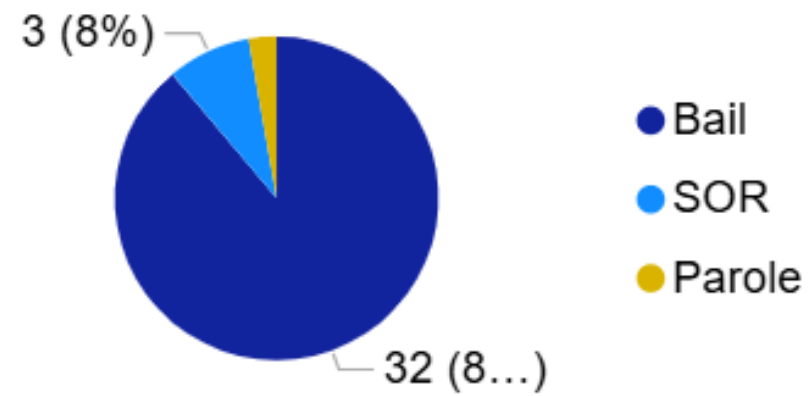

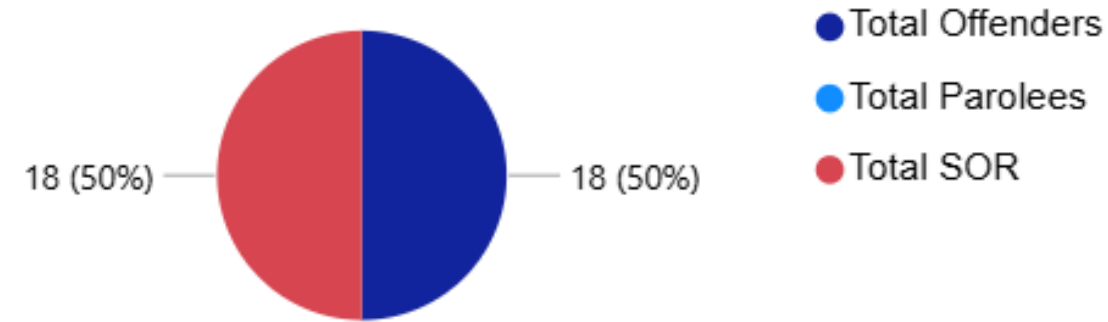

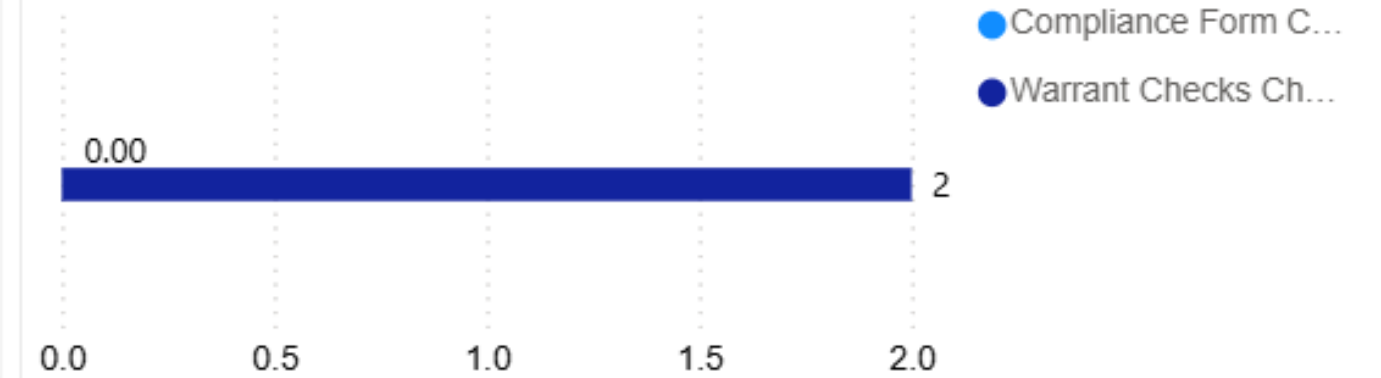
TYPE OF COMPLIANCE CHECK



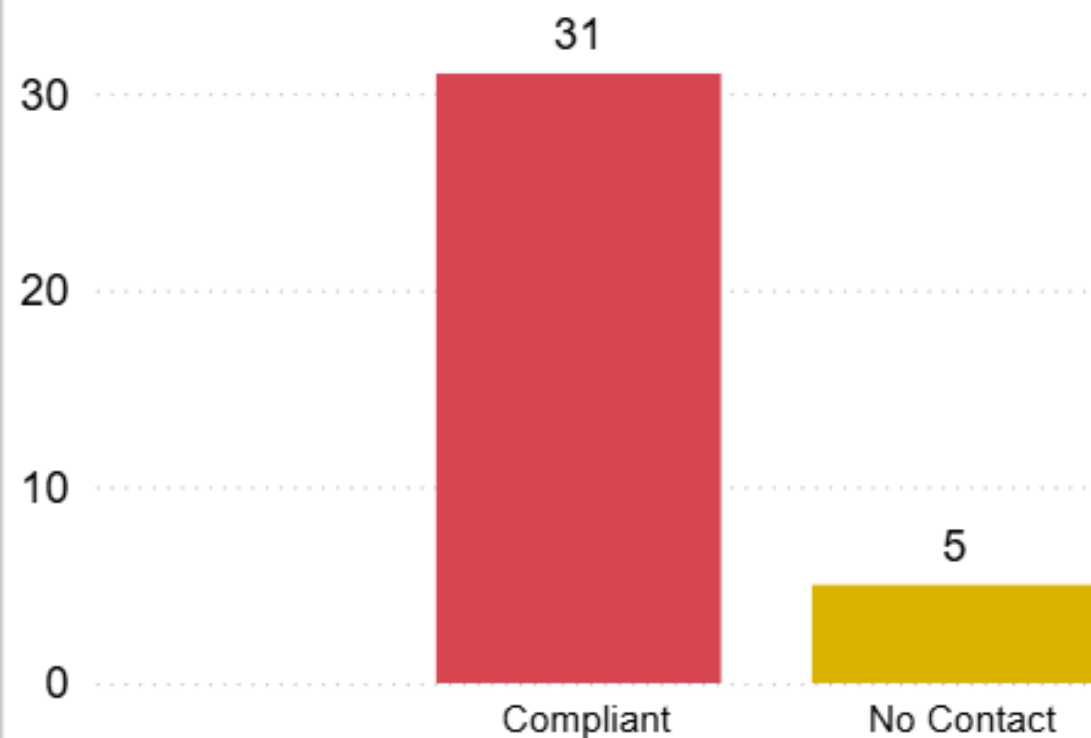
TOTAL OFFENDERS, TOTAL PAROLEES AND TOTAL SOR REGISTERED



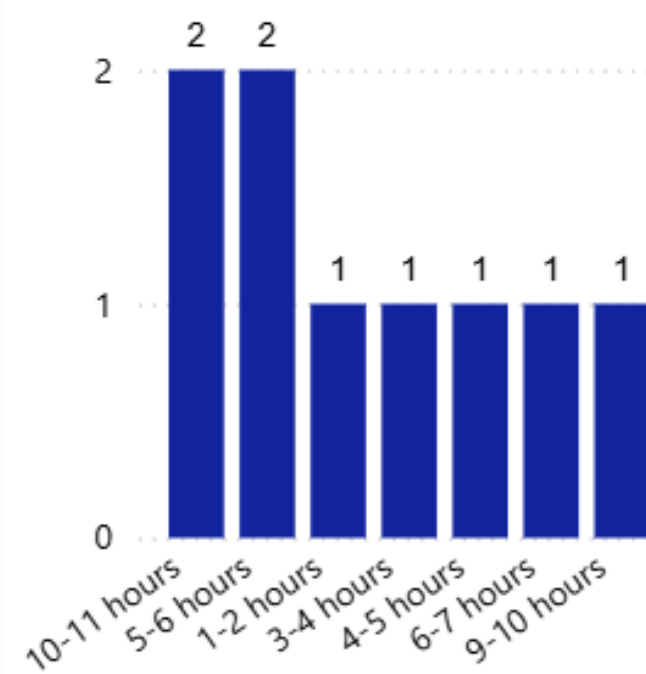
TOTAL # OF CHARGES LAID DURING OFFENDER MANAGEMENT



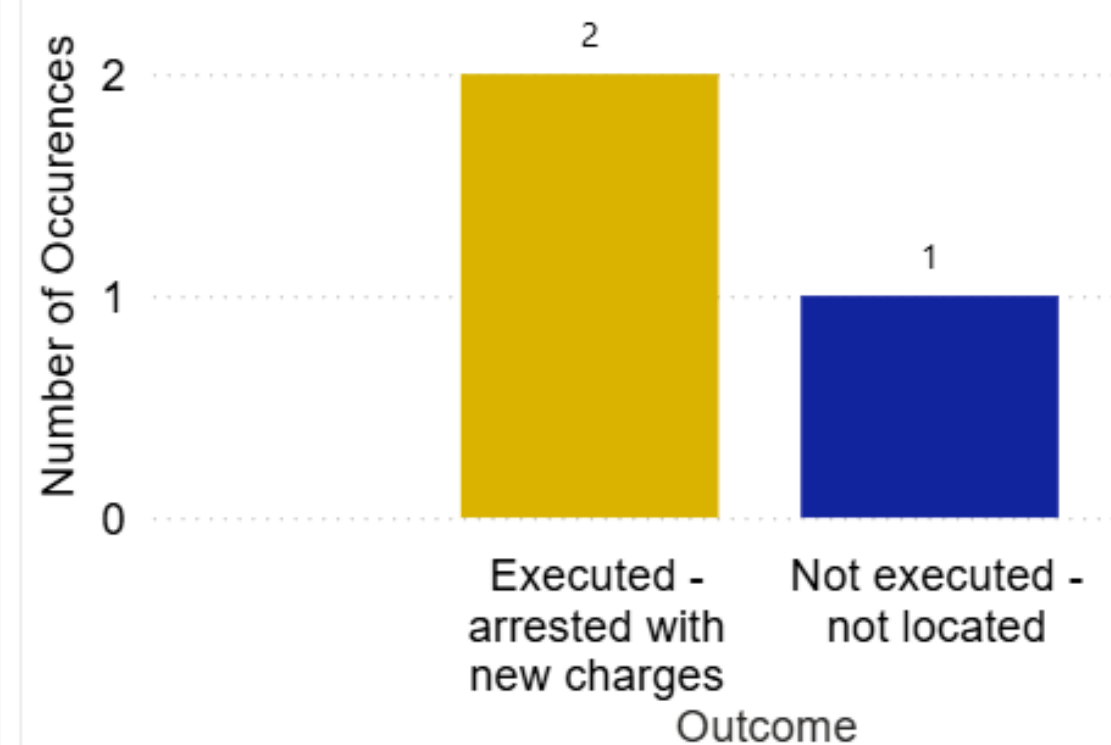
OUTCOME OF COMPLIANCE CHECKS

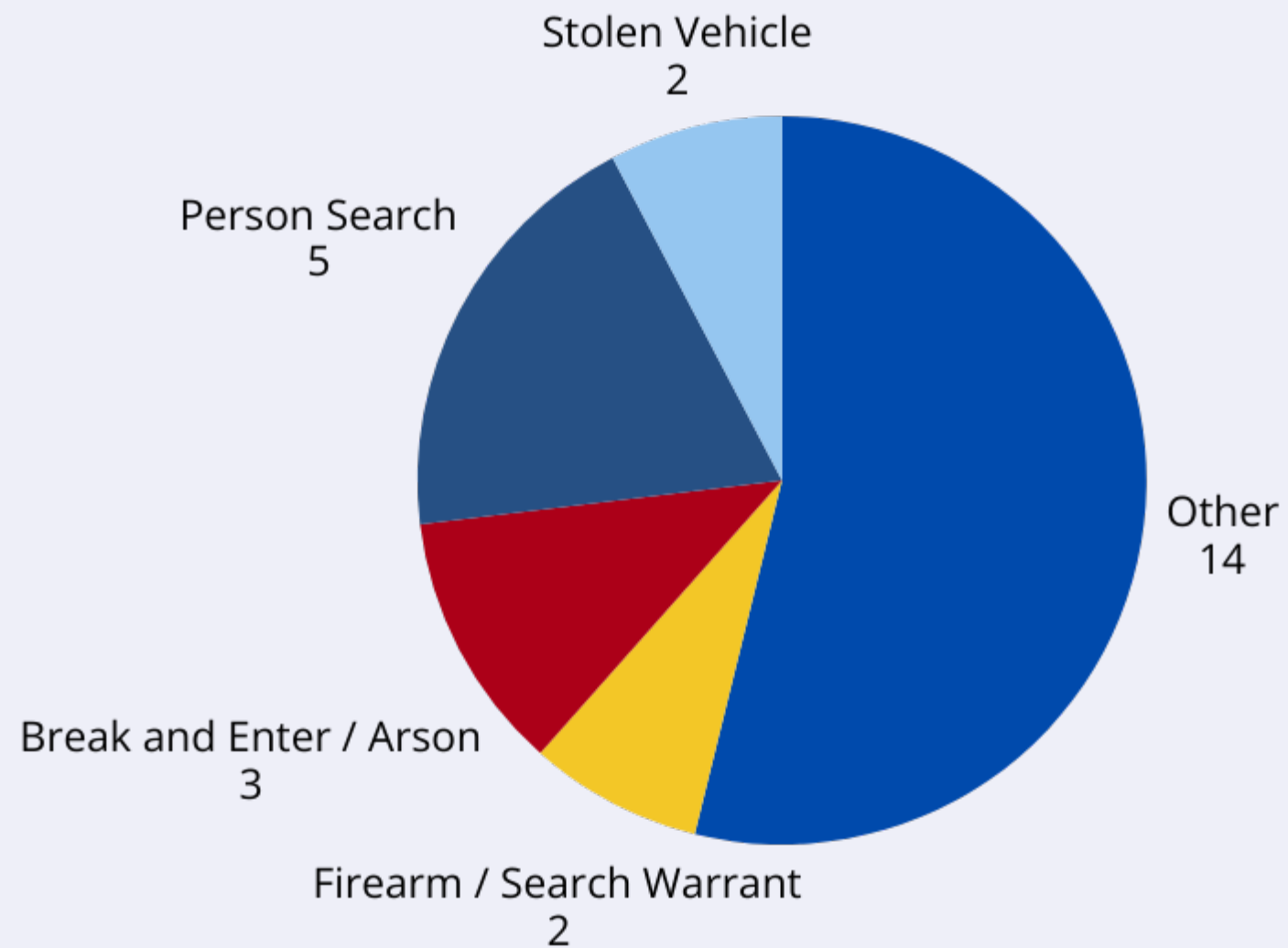
